ORDER:

During the Budget Session for the year 2024-25 on 19.02.2024, the Hon'ble Minister of Finance and Human Resources Management has made the following Announcement among others:-

"The Government will introduce a special scheme in the spinning sector for Technological upgradation by providing interest subvention at 6 percent, at an estimated cost of Rs.500 crore, over the next 10 years"

2. In the letter read above the Commissioner of Textiles has stated that in order to implement the above announcement a committee may be formed to frame guidelines for the special scheme in the spinning sector for Technological upgradation.
